

Setting up an iPad

- Turn on the iPad by pressing the on/off switch located at the top of the device.
- When prompted, swipe to the right.
- Select **English**.
- Country or Region – Select **Canada** | Next.
- Location Services – **Enable** Location Services | Next.
- WiFi Networks – Choose a network. Enter a password if prompted.
- Set Up iPad – Select Set Up as New iPad.
- Apple ID – Sign in with the provided Apple ID.

Go to the Settings App. Select **General** (on the left-hand side) | **About** (on the right-hand side), tap and enter the name of the iPad which should be the same as the label.

Power off.

Setting up **Find My iPad**

- Go to the Settings App on your device.
- Location Services – On
- Find My iPad – Change to On. Allow.
- General – Restrictions. Enable Restrictions.
- Enter the provided passcode - _____ . Type in twice.
- Allow Changes: Location – Check off Don't Allow Changes
- Tap the Restrictions Tab at the top of the page

There should be a padlock displayed under Allow Changes – Location
